In 1938 she and her husband, the famous sculptor Georg Ehrlich, fled the Nazis and settled in London. Her first book to be published in England was in 1943. Bettina wrote and illustrated many lovely books for children in her own inimitable style.

Australian publishing house, *For Pity Sake Publishing* purchased the rights to 6 of Bettina Ehrlich's picture books. *The Goat Boy* is their second release (*Francesco and Francesca* was the first, released in November 2018).
